The minor in East Asian languages and literatures consists of 25 hours of prerequisites and 20 hours of course work beyond the stated prerequisites. The purpose of the prerequisites is to give students a fundamental linguistic and cultural basis upon which to derive an understanding of East Asia.

Selection of courses is made with the advice of the undergraduate director in the Department of East Asian Languages and Literatures or of another member of the DEALL faculty. Note that not all of the courses that are available for the minor are offered every year so that early and careful planning is advised.

Students in the minor must have their minor program approved by the DEALL undergraduate director. Then you should file the form with your college or school counselor. For further information about the minor program, contact the department.

**Prerequisite courses (25 credit hours)**

East Asian Languages and Literatures 131

Select one four-course sequence from below:  
Chinese 101.01, 102.01, 103.01, 104.01  
Japanese 101.01, 102.01, 103.01, 104.01  
Korean 101.01, 102.01, 103.01, 104.01  
or their I.I./SPEAC equivalents when available  
(101.51/101.02; 102.51/102.02; 103.51/103.02;  
104.51/104.02)

**Required courses (10 credit hours)**

Two of the following courses are required.

Chinese 231 or 232  
Japanese 231  
Korean 231

**Elective courses (10-15 credit hours)**

Select these hours from other culture/literature courses in East Asian, Chinese, Japanese, or Korean at the 293 level or above.

**East Asian Languages and Literatures minor program guidelines**

The following guidelines govern this minor.

Required for graduation No

Credit hours required A minimum of 20 plus 25 prerequisite credit hours

Transfer credit hours allowed A maximum of 10

Overlap with the GEC Permitted

Overlap with the major Not allowed and

- The minor must be in a different subject than the major.
- The same courses cannot count on the minor and on the major.

Overlap between minors Each minor completed must contain 20 unique hours.

Grades required

- Minimum C- for a course to be listed on the minor.
- Minimum 2.00 cumulative point-hour ratio required for the minor.
- Course work graded Pass/Non-Pass cannot count on the minor.

Approval required The minor program description sheet indicates if the minor course work must be approved by:

- The academic unit offering the minor

Filing the minor program form The minor program form must be filed at least by the time the graduation application is submitted to a college or school counselor.

Changing the minor Once the minor program is filed in the college office, any changes must be approved by:

- The academic unit offering the minor
