The landscape horticulture minor is designed for individuals who wish to develop an understanding about the production and utilization of landscape plants (trees, shrubs, vines, groundcovers, perennials, annuals) for enhancement of the designed environment (residences, commercial properties, streets, parks, etc). Persons interested in design, gardening, basic science, education, entrepreneurship, or other arts can construct a coherent program of study which will enhance both their educational and career goals.

The landscape horticulture minor consists of 25 hours selected as listed below. Students declaring the minor are strongly encouraged to schedule an appointment with the coordinating adviser listed above to discuss their proposed program. **Required courses (15-16 credit hours)**

Horticulture and Crop Science 200 (5) and 300 (5) or Plant

Biology 300 (5)

Plus one of the following courses: Horticulture and Crop

Science 234 (5), 431 (5), 435 (6), 436 (6)

**Approved electives (9-10 credit hours)**

Horticulture and Crop Science 204 (or Landscape Architecture 204), 320 (4), 401.02 (1-3), 430 (3), 431 (5), 435 (6), 436 (6), 438 (2), 488 (1-3), 501 (5), 502 (5), 521 (5), 533 (5), 560 (4), 600 (5), 697 (1-15)

**Landscape Horticulture minor program guidelines**

The following guidelines govern this minor.

Required for graduation No

Credit hours required A minimum of 25

Transfer credit hours allowed A maximum of 10

Overlap with the GEC Permitted, up to 5 credit hours

Overlap with the major Not allowed and

- The minor must be in a different subject than the major.
- The minor is not available to students majoring in landscape horticulture or horticulture.
- The same courses cannot count on the minor and on the major.

Overlap between minors Each minor completed must contain 20 unique hours.

Grades required

- Minimum C- for a course to be listed on the minor.
- Minimum 2.00 cumulative point-hour ratio required for the minor.
- Course work graded Pass/Non-Pass cannot count on the minor.

Approval required The minor program description sheet indicates if the minor course work must be approved by:

- The academic unit offering the minor

Filing the minor program form The minor program form must be filed at least by the time the graduation application is submitted to a college/school counselor.

Changing the minor Once the minor program is filed in the college office, any changes must be approved by:

- The academic unit offering the minor
