A minor in Portuguese consists of a minimum of 20 hours chosen from the lists below. In special cases 693 can be arranged to a maximum of five hours, but not to replace a regularly scheduled course. Portuguese 401 is required. Please keep in mind that prerequisites must be observed.

After an academic advisor in the Department of Spanish and Portuguese has approved the Minor Program Form, you should file the form with your college or school counselor. For further information about the minor program, contact the department.

Prerequisite courses

Students demonstrate proficiency at the level of 104 by examination or by one of the following paths:

Portuguese 101, 102, 103, 104 (Classroom or I.I. setting)	20 credit hours
Portuguese 501, 502	10 credit hours

Required course (5 credit hours)

Portuguese 401

Elective courses (15 credit hours)

Portuguese 402, 403, 450, 510, 511, 611, 730, 551, 552, 650, 560, 561, 595, 693, 694, 697, 750, H783

Portuguese minor program guidelines

The following guidelines govern this minor.

Required for graduation No

Credit hours required A minimum of 20

Transfer credit hours allowed A maximum of 10

Overlap with the GEC Permitted

Overlap with the major Not allowed and

- The minor must be in a different subject than the major.
- The same courses cannot count on the minor and on the major.

Overlap between minors Each minor completed must contain 20 unique hours.

Grades required

- Minimum C- for a course to be listed on the minor.
- Minimum 2.00 cumulative point-hour ratio required for the minor.
- Course work graded Pass/Non-Pass cannot count on the minor.

Approval required The minor program description sheet indicates if the minor course work must be approved by:

- The academic unit offering the minor

Filing the minor program form The minor program form must be filed at least by the time the graduation application is submitted to a college/school counselor.

Changing the minor Once the minor program is filed in the college office, any changes must be approved by:

- The academic unit offering the minor
