The minor in Russian consists of a minimum of 20 hours of course work beyond Russian 104 as listed below. No more than five hours of credit by examination (EM) or transfer credit can be counted toward the minor.

Students may declare the minor with the approval of either the coordinating adviser in the Department of Slavic and East European Languages and Literatures or their Arts and Sciences advisor. Any variation from the program described here must be approved by the coordinating advisor in the Department of Slavic and East European Languages and Literatures. Russian 405, 407

**Additional courses (10 credit hours)**

Culture

Russian 135 or 250 (only one of these may be counted toward the minor)

And/or any combination of the following courses:

Russian 560, 561, 562, 695

Literature and Culture

Russian 235, 251, 360, 520, 521, 522, 523, 561, 562, 644, 650, 651, 653, 656, 664, 695, 697  
Medieval and Renaissance Studies 213

Other courses may be substituted for the additional courses by permission of the Slavic coordinating advisor.

**Russian minor program guidelines**

The following guidelines govern this minor.

Required for graduation No

Credit hours required A minimum of 20 plus Russian 104

Transfer credit hours allowed A maximum of 5

Overlap with the GEC Permitted

Overlap with the major Not allowed and

- The minor must be in a different subject than the major.
- The same courses cannot count on the minor and on the major.

Overlap between minors Each minor completed must contain 20 unique hours.

Grades required

- Minimum C- for a course to be listed on the minor.
- Minimum 2.00 cumulative point-hour ratio required for the minor.
- Course work graded Pass/Non-Pass cannot count on the minor.

Approval required The minor program description sheet indicates if the minor course work must be approved by:

- The academic unit offering the minor, or
- A college/school counselor

Filing the minor program form The minor program form must be filed at least by the time the graduation application is submitted to a college/school counselor.

Changing the minor Once the minor program is filed in the college office, any changes must be approved by:

- The academic unit offering the minor
