The Spanish Minor for Business consists of 23 credit hours distributed as indicated below. The minor includes four courses taught in Spanish and one course taught in English. The Spanish Minor for Business is not open to Honors students. All Honors students, regardless of their major or college of enrollment, are required to follow the Honors Spanish programs. Honors students must take H450 and fulfill additional requirements.

After an academic advisor in the Department of Spanish and Portuguese has approved the Minor Program Form, you should file the form with your college or school counselor. For further information about the minor program, contact the department.

Prerequisite courses

Prerequisite: **Spanish 250**. Students generally progress from 104 or 111 to 250, and then into minor courses. Students who complete Spanish H104 and those with documentation of a Spanish AP score of 4 or higher, may skip Spanish 250 and move directly from 100-level into upper-level courses, after successfully completing the SLRPE.

Major/Minor Entrance Exam: The *Spanish Listening & Reading Proficiency Exam* (SLRPE) is administered in multiple sessions quarterly. Passing scores on both portions of the SLRPE is a prerequisite to entry into all undergraduate Spanish courses at the 400-level and above. Students are eligible to register for the SLRPE as early as the 5th week of *H104 or 250*, and is offered to other students who meet eligibility requirements.

Spanish Minor for Business program guidelines

The following guidelines govern this minor.

Required for graduation No

Credit hours required A minimum of 23

Transfer credit hours allowed A maximum of 10

Overlap with the GEC Not permitted

Overlap with the major Not allowed and

- The minor must be in a different subject than the major.
- The same courses cannot count on the minor and on the major.

Overlap between minors Each minor completed must contain 20 unique hours.

Grades required

- Minimum C- for a course to be listed on the minor.
- Minimum 2.00 cumulative point-hour ratio required for the minor.
- Course work graded Pass/Non-Pass cannot count on the minor.

Approval required The minor program description sheet indicates if the minor course work must be approved by:

- The academic unit offering the minor

Filing the minor program form The minor program form must be filed at least by the time the graduation application is submitted to a college/school counselor.

Changing the minor Once the minor program is filed in the college office, any changes must be approved by:

- The academic unit offering the minor
