The theatre minor consists of 24 credit hours tailored to meet the needs and interests of the individual student. A minimum of 12 credit hours must be at the 300 level or above. No more than five hours of X93 and X94 course work can be used on the minor.

After a faculty member in the Department of Theatre has approved your Minor Program Form, you must file the form with your college or school counselor. For further information, contact the department.

Theatre minor program guidelines

The following guidelines govern this minor.

Required for graduation No

Credit hours required A minimum of 24

Transfer credit hours allowed A maximum of 10

Overlap with the GEC

- Students may double count courses taken for the minor with requirements in the GEC

Overlap with the major Not allowed and

- The minor must be in a different subject than the major.
- The same courses cannot count on the minor and on the major.

Overlap between minors Each minor completed must contain 20 unique hours.

Grades required

- Minimum C- for a course to be listed on the minor.
- Minimum 2.00 cumulative point-hour ratio required for the minor.
- Course work graded Pass/Non-Pass cannot count on the minor.

Approval required The minor program description sheet indicates if the minor course work must be approved by:

- The academic unit offering the minor

Filing the minor program form The minor program form must be filed at least by the time the graduation application is submitted to a college/school counselor.

Changing the minor Once the minor program is filed in the college office, any changes must be approved by:

- The academic unit offering the minor
