The minor in turfgrass management is for students who expect to have positions that require overseeing the management of grounds (for example airports, factories, roadsides, schools, lawns, and recreational areas.)

The turfgrass management minor consists of 20-24 hours selected as listed below. If you follow the guidelines on this sheet in completing the minor, you should file the Minor Program Form with your college or school counselor. Any variation from the program described on this sheet needs the approval of the coordinating or assistant coordinating adviser.

Turfgrass Management minor program guidelines

The following guidelines govern this minor.

Required for graduation No

Credit hours required A minimum of 20-24

Transfer credit hours allowed A maximum of 10

Overlap with the GEC Permitted, up to 5 credit hours

Overlap with the major Not allowed and

- The minor must be in a different subject than the major.
- The minor is not available to students majoring in agronomy, crop science, horticulture, landscape horticulture, or turfgrass science.
- The same courses cannot count on the minor and on the major.

Overlap between minors Each minor completed must contain 20 unique hours.

Grades required

- Minimum C- for a course to be listed on the minor.
- Minimum 2.00 cumulative point-hour ratio required for the minor.
- Course work graded Pass/Non-Pass cannot count on the minor.

Approval required The minor program description sheet indicates if the minor course work must be approved by:

- A college/school counselor

Filing the minor program form The minor program form must be filed at least by the time the graduation application is submitted to a college/school counselor.

Changing the minor Once the minor program is filed in the college office, any changes must be approved by:

- A college/school counselor
