Women's Studies Minor (Wom Stds, 493)

The minor in women's studies consists of a minimum of 25 credit hours, at least 15 of which must be at the 300 level or above, including five credit hours at the 500 level or above. No more than five credit hours of combined special topics (294, 494) or individual studies (693) may be used to fulfill minor requirements. After the Women's Studies advisor in the Department of Women's Studies approves your Minor Program Form, you must file the form with your college or school counselor.

All women's studies students must complete the following courses for the minor:

- at least one of the following: Women's Studies 101, 110, 300;
- at least one of the following: Women's Studies 340, 367.02, 367.04, 372, 505, 520, 540, 576, 623, 624; and
- 15 hours from the following list of women's studies and discipline-based courses.

Women's Studies minor program guidelines

The following guidelines govern Women's Studies minors.

Required for graduation No

Credit hours required: 25 for the Women's Studies Minor

Transfer credit hours allowed A maximum of 10
Overlap with the GEC: Courses used for the Women's Studies Minor may be used as GEC's.

Overlap with the major Not allowed and

- The minor must be in a different subject than the major.
- The same courses cannot count for the minor and for the major.

Overlap between minors Each minor completed must contain 20 unique hours.

Grades required

- Minimum C- for a course to be listed on the minor.
- Minimum 2.00 cumulative point-hour ratio required for the minor.
- Course work graded Pass/Non-Pass cannot count for the minor.

Approval required The Women's Studies minor program form must be approved by a Women's Studies advisor in the Department of Women's Studies.

Filing the minor program form The Women's Studies minor program form must be filed in the student's college immediately after being filled out by the Women's Studies advisor. The student should not wait until applying for graduation to file the minor form.

Changing the minor Once the Women's Studies minor program form is filed in the college office, any changes must be approved by:

- The Women's Studies advisor in the Department of Women's Studies.
