The zoology minor requires a minimum of 20 credit hours. The core requirements are EEOB 400 or H400; EEOB 405.01; EEOB 410 or 413.01; and Molecular Genetics 500, or 605 and 606. Additional courses needed to attain the minimum of 20 hours may be elected from other courses taught at the 200 level or higher in EEOB (but excluding EEOB 232 and 235). If you complete the minor following these guidelines, you need only file your Minor Program Form with your college or school adviser. Any variation in the program described above needs the approval of the zoology coordinating adviser in the Department of Evolution, Ecology, and Organismal Biology. For further information about the minor program, contact the zoology coordinating adviser.

Required courses (20 credit hours)

- Evolution, Ecology, and Organismal Biology 400 or H400
- Evolution, Ecology, and Organismal Biology 405.01
- Evolution, Ecology, and Organismal Biology 410 or 413.01
- Molecular Genetics 500 or 605 and 606
- Additional 200-level or higher credit hours in Evolution, Ecology, and Organismal biology (excluding 232 and 235) to total 20 credit hours

Zoology minor program guidelines

The following guidelines govern this minor.

Required for graduation No

Credit hours required A minimum of 20

Transfer credit hours allowed A maximum of 10

Overlap with the GEC Permitted

Overlap with the major Not allowed and

- The minor must be in a different subject than the major.
- The same courses cannot count on the minor and on the major.

Overlap between minors Each minor completed must contain 20 unique hours.

Grades required

- Minimum C- for a course to be listed on the minor.
- Minimum 2.00 cumulative point-hour ratio required for the minor.
- Course work graded Pass/Non-Pass cannot count on the minor.

Approval required The minor program description sheet indicates if the minor course work must be approved by:

- A college/school counselor

Filing the minor program form The minor program form must be filed at least by the time the graduation application is submitted to a college/school counselor.

Changing the minor Once the minor program is filed in the college office, any changes must be approved by:

- A college/school counselor
