Purpose: Students will understand business management concepts important for effective farm-level decision making and an opportunity to develop an array of skills needed to manage production, finance, marketing, and human resources.

Requirements and Responsibilities: Students are responsible for planning their minor program to achieve **a minimum of 12 hours**. AEDECON 2001 (200) or Econ 2001 (200) is a prerequisite. **At least six (6) credits must be at the 3000 level or above.**

This minor is not available to students majoring in Agribusiness and Applied Economics.

Farm Management minor program guidelines

The following guidelines govern this minor:

Required for graduation No

<u>Credit hours required</u> A minimum of 12 credit hrs. 1000 level courses shall not be counted toward the 12 credit hr minimum.

<u>Transfer and EM credit hours allowed</u> A student is permitted to count up to 6 total hours of transfer credit and/or credit by examination.

Overlap with the GE A student is permitted to overlap up to 6 credit hours between the GE and the minor.

Overlap with the major and additional minor(s)

- The minor must be in a different subject than the major.
- The minor must contain a minimum of 12 distinct hours from the major and/or additional minor(s).

Grades required

- Minimum C- for a course to be listed on the minor.
- Minimum 2.00 cumulative GPA for all minor course work.
- Course work graded Pass/Non-Pass cannot count in the minor.
- No more than 3 credit hours of coursework graded Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory may count toward the minor.

<u>X193 credits</u> No more than 3 credit hours of x193 may count toward the minor.

<u>Minor approval</u> Not required as long as students complete the courses as indicated on the minor program description.

<u>Filing the minor program form</u> The minor program form must be filed at least by the time the graduation application is submitted to a college/school counselor.

<u>Changing the minor</u> Once the minor program is filed in the college office, any changes must be approved by filing a petition for change in the minor through the academic unit offering the minor.
