The minor in Human and Animal Interactions is designed for students who wish to develop a broader understanding of the benefits and importance of human and animal interactions. It will appeal to students with an interest in understanding the past, present and future of relationships between humans and animals.

The Human and Animal Interactions minor consists of a minimum of 12 credit hours. Collectively, the required courses and elective courses must total a minimum of 12 semester hours. At least 6 of the 12 credit hours must be at the 3000 level or above.

Human and Animal Interactions minor program quidelines:

<u>Credit hours required</u> A minimum of 12 credit hrs. 1000 level courses shall not be counted in the minor. At least 6 credits must be upper-division course (3000 level or above) as defined by the College of Food, Agricultural, and Environmental Sciences.

<u>Transfer and EM credit hours allowed</u> A student is permitted to count up to 6 total hours of transfer credit and/or credit by examination.

Overlap with the GE A student is permitted to overlap up to 6 credit hours between the GE and the minor.

Overlap with the major and additional minor(s)

- The minor must be in a different subject than the major.
- The minor must contain a minimum of 12 hours distinct from the major and/or additional minor(s).

Grades required

- Minimum C- for a course to be listed on the minor.
- Minimum 2.00 cumulative GPA for all minor course work.
- Course work graded Pass/Non-Pass cannot count in the minor.
- No more than 3 credit hours of coursework graded Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory may count toward the minor.

X193 credits No more than 3 credit hours.

<u>Minor approval</u> Not required as long as students complete the courses as indicated on the minor program description.

<u>Filing the minor program form</u> The minor program form must be filed at least by the time the graduation application is submitted to a college/school advisor.

<u>Changing the minor</u> Once the minor program is filed in the college office, any changes must be approved by filing a petition for change in the minor through the academic unit offering the minor.
