Russian Minor (RUSSIAN-MN)

The Russian minor aims at developing your language proficiency so that you can handle survival topics and a range of everyday communicative tasks in straightforward social situations. In addition, you will take coursework to increase your appreciation and understanding of Russian culture, develop your analytical skills, and give you an international outlook. The minor consists of four classes (13 credits)—second-year Russian 2 and 3 electives selected from a menu of literature and culture courses.

**Prerequisites (12 cr)**

Russian 1101, 1102, 1103

**Required course (4 cr)**

Russian 2104

**Elective courses (9 cr)**

*Choose 3 courses from the following list; at least one course must be at the 3000-level or higher:*

MRS 2513

Russian 2250, 2250H, 2335, 2345, 3350, 3460, 4220, 4221, 4600, 5250 (repeatable with change of content), 5530

*The following courses can be used as part of a Russian minor program with permission of the Undergraduate Studies Chair:*

Russian 4191, 4798, 5193, 5194, 5797

Slavic 2230, 3310, 3360, 4260H, 4520, 4560H, 4597, 4760

*Occasionally, other courses may be offered in the Slavic Department or in other departments that can fit into a Russian minor. Such substitutions require the approval of the program's Undergraduate Studies Chair.*

**Russian Minor Program Guidelines:**

Required for graduation No

Credit hours required A minimum of 13 credit hrs. 1000 level courses shall not be counted in the minor.

Transfer and EM credit hours allowed

A student is permitted to count up to 6 total hours of transfer credit and/or credit by examination.

Overlap with the GE

A student is permitted to overlap up to 6 credit hours between the GE and the minor.

Overlap with the major and additional minor(s)

- The minor must be in a different subject than the major.
- The minor must contain a minimum of 12 hours distinct from the major and/or additional minor(s).

Grades required

- Minimum C- for a course to be listed on the minor.
- Minimum 2.00 cumulative point-hour ratio required for the minor.
- Course work graded Pass/Non-Pass cannot count on the minor.
- No more than 3 credit hours of coursework graded Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory may count toward the minor.

X193 credits No more than 3 credit hours.

Minor approval The minor program must be approved by the academic advisor for Russian and Slavic. Any substitutions must be approved by the department's Undergraduate Studies Chair.

Filing the minor program form The minor program form must be filed at least by the time the graduation application is submitted to a college/school counselor.

Changing the minor Once the minor program is filed in the college office, any changes must be approved by the academic advisor for Russian and Slavic.
