The minor in Medieval and Renaissance studies consists of a minimum of 15 credit hours and is designed to serve those students planning to pursue graduate degrees in Medieval and Renaissance areas of study and those who wish to learn more about these periods while they prepare for careers in other fields.

Students planning to complete a minor program in Medieval and Renaissance studies should first consult the department undergraduate advisor. After the advisor approves your Minor Program Form, you must file the form with your college or school counselor.

A minimum of 15 credit hours, with the following distribution criteria, must be met:

- Courses must be selected from the Center's list of approved courses;
- Courses must be offered by departments other than the department of your major;
- Courses must be chosen from the list of approved courses according to the following breakdown in credit hours:
  - Medieval and Renaissance Studies courses (6 hours)
  - text-based courses (3 hours)
  - civilization courses (3 hours)
  - art courses (3 credit hours);
- At least 9 credit hours must be taken in courses at the 3000 level and above, 6 credit hours may be at the 2000 level;
- Credit for individual study and workshop courses may not exceed three hours; and,
- Credits from seminars and special topics courses offered by affiliated departments may count toward the degree upon approval by the CMRS advisor.

**Medieval & Renaissance Studies minor program guidelines**

Required for graduation No

Credit hours required A minimum of 15 credit hrs. 1000 level courses shall not be counted in the minor. At least 9 credit hours must be taken in courses at the 3000 level and above, 6 credit hours may be at the 2000 level;

### Transfer and EM credit hours allowed

A student is permitted to count up to 6 total hours of transfer credit and/or credit by examination.

Overlap with the GE A student is permitted to overlap up to 6 credit hours between the GE and the minor.

### Overlap with the major and additional minor(s)

- The minor must be in a different subject than the major.
- The minor must contain a minimum of 12 hours distinct from the major and/or additional minor(s).

### Grades required

- Minimum C- for a course to be listed on the minor.
- Minimum 2.00 cumulative point-hour ratio required for the minor.
- Course work graded Pass/Non-Pass cannot count on the minor.
  - No more than 3 credit hours of coursework graded Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory may count toward the minor.

Credit for individual study and workshop courses may not exceed three hours

Minor approval The minor program must be approved by the academic unit offering the minor.

Filing the minor program form The minor program form must be filed at least by the time the graduation application is submitted to a college/school counselor.

Changing the minor Once the minor program is filed in the college office, any changes must be approved by the academic unit offering the minor.
