Surveying and Mapping minor program guidelines

The following guidelines govern this minor:

Required for graduation No

Credit hours required A minimum of 19 credit hrs. At least 6 credit hrs must be 3000-level or above.

Transfer and EM credit hours allowed A student is permitted to count up to 6 total hours of transfer credit and/or credit by examination.

Overlap with the GE A student is permitted to overlap up to 6 credit hours between the GE and the minor.

Overlap with the major and additional minor(s)

- The minor must be in a different subject than the major.
- The minor must contain a minimum of 12 hours distinct from the major and/or additional minor(s).

Grades required

- Minimum C- for a course to be listed on the minor.
- Minimum 2.00 cumulative point-hour ratio required for the minor.
- Coursework graded Pass/Non-Pass cannot count on the minor.

Minor Approval A student who completes the minor following the requirements need only file their college's minor program form with their academic advisor or college office.

Filing the minor program form: The minor program form must be filed at least by the time the graduation application is submitted to a college/school counselor.
